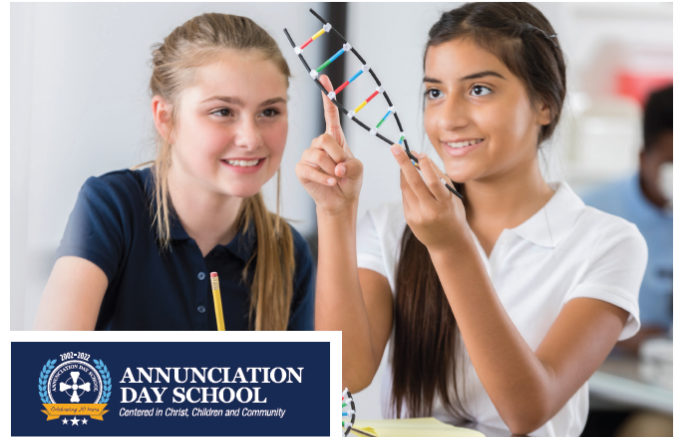
Philoptochos Scholarships

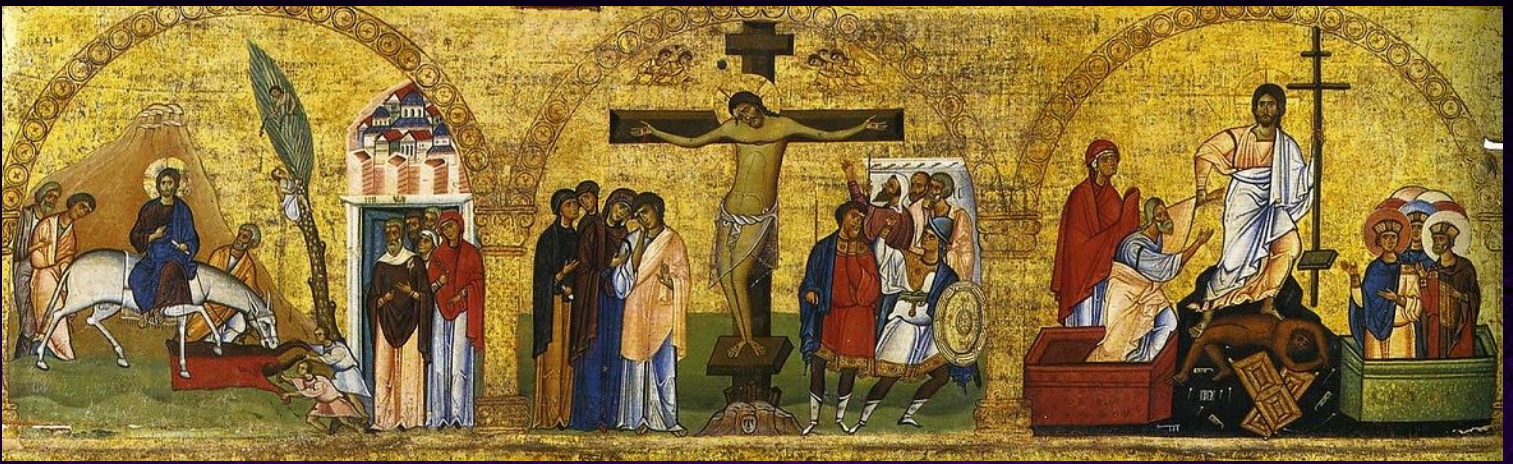
