

Update Your Email Preferences

As our parish grows, we understand that email communications also need to evolve. We are excited to share that we've updated our email preferences center. You may now opt-in and out of different email topics according to your preference. Here's how Cathedral communications will be managed going forward:

Everyone who is actively subscribed to the Cathedral email list will receive **General Communications** (Annunciator, Stewardship/Fundraising, Philoptochos, Archdiocese / Metropolis news, Memorials/Fallen asleep in the Lord, etc.) and **Critical Alerts** (e.g., new staff, closures, changes in policy) by default.

For all other communication, click the "Update Profile" link at the bottom of any Cathedral email. Opt-out of those topics you do not wish to receive.

How to update your preferences:

- Visit "Update Profile" at the bottom of any cathedral email
- Click submit
- Open the email you received and click update preferences
- Update your email preferences and uncheck any topic you do **not want** to receive.
- Submit!
