The Apostles' Fast
Every year, from the day following the Sunday of All Saints (this year June 11th) through June 29th, fasting is prescribed in preparation for the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul (June 29th). Due to the fact that All Saints is a moveable feast, falling on the Sunday following Pentecost (the previous week, there is no fasting prescribed), the Apostles' Fast varies in length from year to year. For example, the Fast may last many weeks, or, when the Feast falls on or prior to All Saints there is no Fast at all! For this year, the Apostles' Fast begins on Monday, June 12th, and ends on June 29th.



Archiepiscopal Encyclical on the National Sisterhood of Presvyteres Sunday

June 11, 2023

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Holy Archdiocese of America:

Receive her in the Lord in a manner worthy of saints, and place whatever she needs at her disposal. For, she has been a real champion to many, and to me as well! (Romans 16:2)

Beloved Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On this National Sisterhood of Presvyteres Sunday, let us call to mind these words of Saint Paul for all of our Presvyteres, which were indeed personal for the Deaconess Phoebe. But they could truly be said of each and every Presvytera, who deserve to be received and treated "in a manner worthy of the saints." These special sisters in Christ give to our communities every day, by supporting the work of their husbands and by being the anchors for our clergy families. Indeed, we should always place at their disposal what they need for spiritual and material success.

We associate this day with the Feastday of the Holy Sisters Mary and Martha, which this year falls on Pentecost Sunday. These sisters represent the right and left hands of contemplation and service, and are a fitting paradigm of ministry and devotion for any Presvytera. Let us, therefore, recognize our beloved Presvyteres as real champions within our communities, and accord them the honor that is their due.
