The Apostles' Fast

Every year, from the day following the Sunday of All Saints (this year June 20th) through June 29th, fasting is prescribed in preparation for the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul (June 29th). Due to the fact that All Saints is a moveable feast, falling on the Sunday following Pentecost (the previous week, there is no fasting prescribed), the Apostles' Fast varies in length from year to year. For example, the Fast may last many weeks, or, when the Feast falls on or prior to All Saints there is no Fast at all! For this year, the Apostles' Fast begins on Monday, June 20th and ends on June 29th.
