



Of all the things we can do in life, one of the most essential things is to worship God through offering our prayers and thanksgiving.

Prosphora, which means offering, (Liturgical Bread), is a tangible way we can demonstrate our love for God our creator. We take the elements of the earth He created and form those ingredients into Prosphora and offer them back to Him in the Divine Liturgy. Our Lord consecrates those gifts and returns a portion of them back to us in the Holy Eucharist. The remainder we receive as Holy Antidoron (instead of the Holy Gifts). What a blessed way to participate in the Divine Liturgy!

At this time, we especially need your participation and assistance. Our beloved Cathedral will need approximately 100 Prosphora loaves throughout Great Lent, Holy Week and Pascha. Please consider offering as much as you are able during this Holy Season. You may drop off your Prosphora with the names of your family members, both living and departed, at the Cathedral Offices during the week. Or you may give them to a Parish Council member when you come to worship. Thank you!
