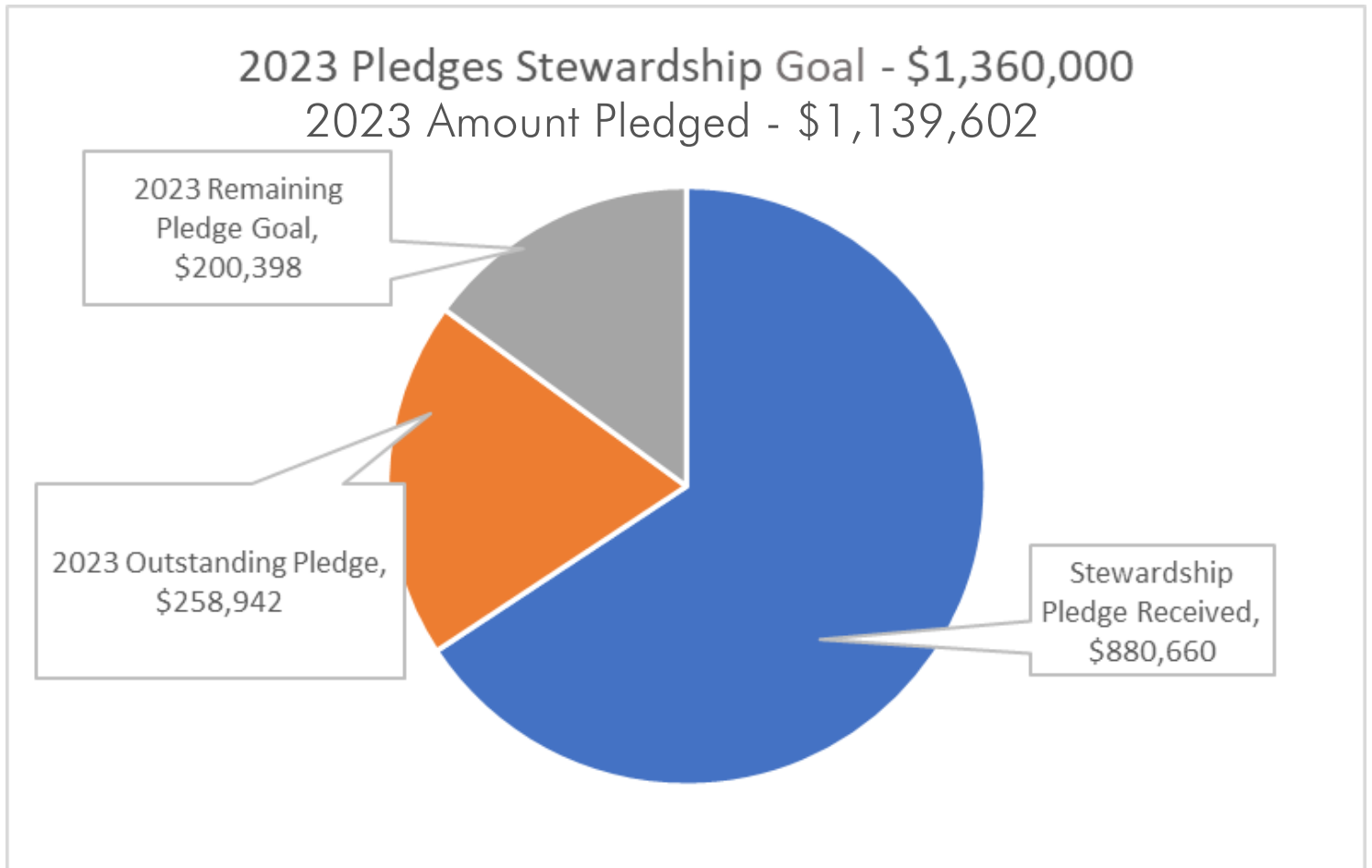

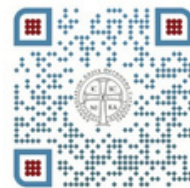

Ed Nash, our honored speaker, is a Marine combat veteran of the Vietnam War. He was a reconnaissance specialist seeking out the Vietcong in the jungles of Vietnam, a very dangerous duty. After the war he spent much of his time with veterans' mental health issues including counseling suicidal veterans. You don't want to miss our speaker's presentation and our annual tribute to the men and women who have served in the Armed Forces.

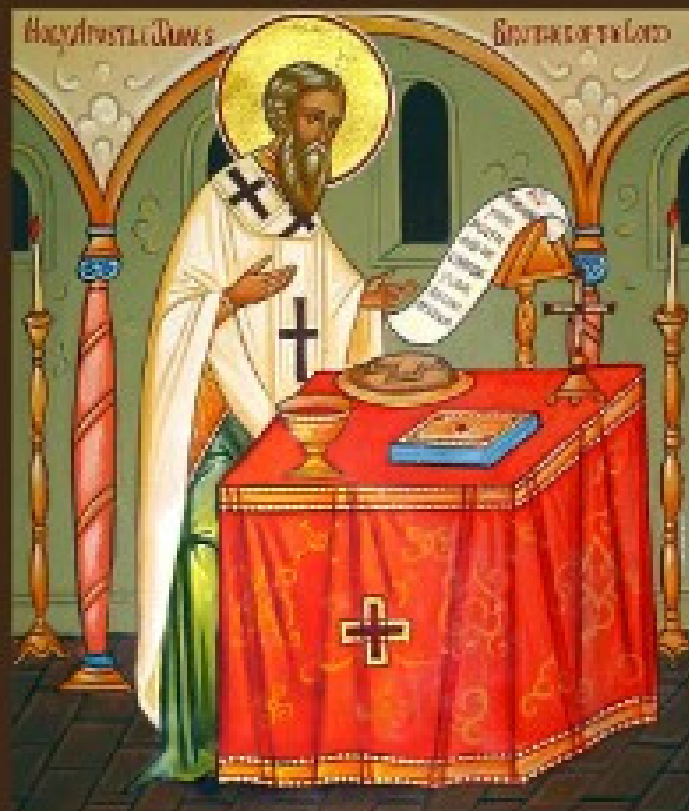
