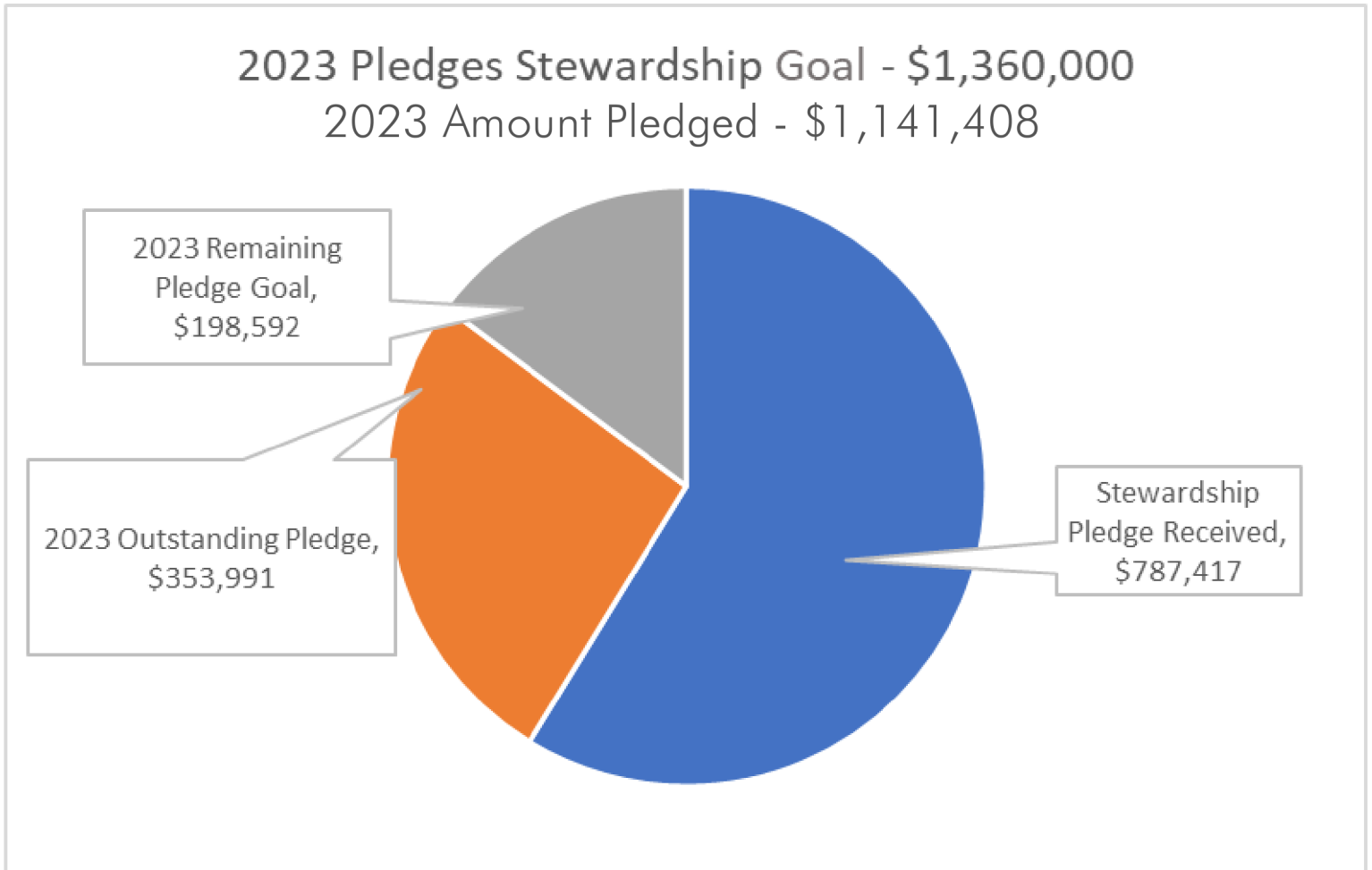

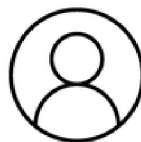

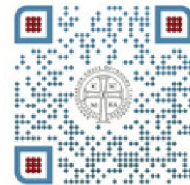

The history includes the story of how the ladies of the St. Barbara Society formed their association, planned and underwrote the Chapel, and then oversaw its construction.

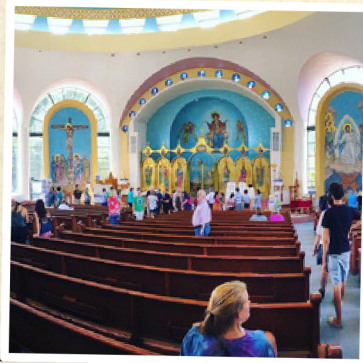
The history will be available for purchase for \$10 in the Church bookstore on Sunday, September 3.
